## Lung Cancer Screening: What to Expect

### How is the test performed?

Your lung cancer screening will be performed by a low-dose computed tomography or CT scanner, which is a large donut-shaped machine that produces multiple images of the inside of your body. During the scan, you will lie on your back on a table that slowly slides through the scanner. Both ends of the machine are completely open for you to see and hear outside of the machine.

### When and how will I get my results?

After your scan, a radiologist will review and interpret your CT images. The results and recommendations will also be provided to your primary care physician.

### Is lung cancer screening covered under insurance?

Most private health plans as well as Medicare and Medicaid cover lung cancer screening for eligible individuals. Most follow-up care required after the exam should also be covered by your insurance or Medicare/Medicaid.
